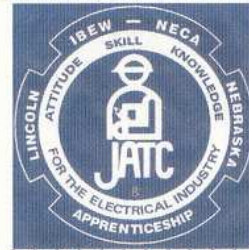


Current Classes offered by Lincoln JATC
