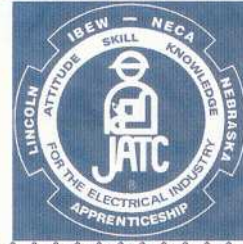


Current Classes offered by Lincoln JATC

Labor History Class—Part 2

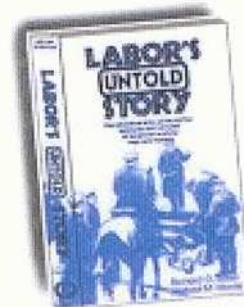
Dates: March 16 and 30, 2009
